The monthly Work meeting of the Hardwick Township Committee was held on this date at the Municipal Building, 40 Spring Valley Road, Hardwick, New Jersey. This meeting was called to order at 7:05PM by the Township Clerk Judith Fisher who noted that this meeting was being held in compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act":

70 Birch Ridge Road: Mr. Rodman noted that he and the Zoning Officer, George Boesze will be meeting next Wednesday with Ms. Ladlee, owner of the property. Purpose of this meeting is to inspecteed her driveway/farmland access to the house.

Presentation: Mike Murphy from City Connections

Mr. Murphy talked about their web noting that it was founded in 1995. He was able to show the Committee various webs that they have designed and are managing presently. They specialize in Municipal Websites and listed their current NJ Municipalities. Transition time, if Hardwick were to use them, would be about 4 to 6 months. Mr. Murphy's proposal included the cost to design and build, annual charges and optional services.

The Committee thanked Mr. Murphy for coming in tonight.

Mr. Duffy has also received another proposal from Weblinx, an Illinois Corporation established in 2001. They were not present tonight, but submitted their proposal for a web design and digital marketing solutions. Their proposal included a summary of the scope of work and project fees. Timeline for the completion would be 12 weeks.

Since Mr. Carrazzone was not present tonight, the Committee will discuss these proposal at the next meeting when there is a full Committee.

Mr. Rodman, Engineer talked to the Committee about the issue at 70 Birch Ridge Road. The owner turned a farm lane into her driveway. This issue was discussed earlier in the meeting.

Land Use Board: Mayor Perry talked to the Committee about forming a Land Use Board. This would combine the Board of Adjustment and Planning Board, noting that the Township appreciated the work that Zoning Board Secretary, Alfia Schemm and its Members have accomplished. Mayor Perry has asked the Township Attorney, Mr. Lavery to draft the ordinance merging the two Boards. This will be on the April Agenda for review and discussion.

COAH: The settlement agreement has been reviewed by Ms. Katrina Campbell, an attorney with the Law Firm of Lavery, Selvaggi, Abromitis & Cohen. This agreement is for the Fair Share Housing.
